## **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

1. Recovery operations continue on a 24-hour basis.
2. Slurry Wall Tiebacks continue.
3. Debris removal from WTC 6 Completed, building signed off on 5/10/02
4. FDNY demobilization report completed and submitted to DDC (5/10/02)

## **CONTINUING ACTIONS**

1. Operations continue on debris removal from the North and South pit areas.
2. Bankers Trust (130 Liberty St.), sprinkler system is still OOS. Standpipe system has been filled. The manual fire pump is functional; the automatic pump is not in service. The two service elevators located on the south side are in service, with phase 1&2 of Fireman Service available.
3. Standpipe at 90 West Street is partially OOS and is presently dry. FDNY can supply the Siamese only on West St. Contractor will forward a report each day on the number of workers and floor they are working.

## **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. No open flames or warming fires. All fires will be extinguished by FDNY.
2. Operations Chief shall designate 3 Safety Chiefs per tour.
3. PPE requirements are as follows: SEE DDC ATTACHMENT.
4. FDNY personnel parking is located on the south side of Warren St. (corner of West St.) Coveralls will be available at the FD Warren St. parking lot.
5. The Global Positioning System (GPS) is used to plot the location of all victims, remains, and fire equipment. If GPS is not operational, GPS operators will manually record locations using a grid map dated 9/20/01 or later. GPS units are available via channel 3 on our Handie-Talkie.
6. When undamaged SCBA or compressed gas cylinders are found, the Sector Chief will contact 10/10 for EPA notification. EPA - # (203) 627 - 9332
7. Prior to any steel cutting operation inside of buildings, FDNY should ensure adequate fire extinguishers are made available by the contractor performing the work.
8. Operations Chief and SOC Chief shall attend Contractors Meeting inside BOVIS Trailer, at 0800, 1730 hours.
9. West Street siamese for 3 WFC is OOS. Use Vesey Street siamese if needed.
10. When valuable personal objects are found (necklace, watches, etc.) notify a chief officer who will document all pertinent information in the West Hut Journal. FDNY Operations command post shall notify PAPD and/or NYPD. Valuables shall be turned over to the responding Police Officer. The Police Officer's name and shield number shall be recorded.
11. Hydration station is in operation under the bridge.

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
